

OLYMPICS 2008 - PEKING (CHINA)





For the Olympic Games 2008 in Peking, many fascinating buildings were constructed such as the National Stadium, also called "Birds Nest", or the National Swimming Center, also known as "Water Cube".

The exterior solvering of the Swimming Center consists of 3,000 air filled sushings made of a special transparent file.

The exterior covering of the Swimming Center consists of 3,000 air-filled cushions made of a special transparent film. This film is capable of lighting up in over 1,670 shades of colour and offers a spectacular play of colours.
